

My Pre-school Social Story (Robin Room)



When I get to the big school gates, I will need to walk with my mum
(or dad or whoever is bringing me) down the road to the gate to
Robin Garden



I will need to say bye to my mum/dad/carers at the gate and walk in
to the garden with my bag (on my first day) and my lunch bag (if I
am staying all day). One of my teachers will greet me in the garden.



Once inside, one of my teachers will take me to my peg to hang up my things and I will put my lunch bag (if staying for lunch) in the trolley in Robin side. **(Unless your child is coming in at lunchtime, in which case they will go straight to the lunch table).**



After I have hung up my things, I will go with my teacher to the bathroom to wash my hands. It's really important that I do this properly. My teachers will help me and we will sing our hand-washing song "this is the way we wash our hands, wash our hands, wash our hands, this is the way we wash our hands and wash the germs away" (to the tune of "here we go round the mulberry bush"), three times over. **(This will be the same if your child is coming for an afternoon session).**



For the first 45 minutes I will stay in Robin Room to play.



If I need the toilet, I can go to the Robin side of the bathroom. A teacher will be on hand to help. I will need to wash my hands really well, singing "this is the way we wash our hands, wash our hands, wash our hands, this is the way we wash our hands and wash the germs away", three times over.

(Only relevant if your child is in nappies)

If I am wearing a nappy, my key person will help me if I need to get changed. She will need to wear some special protective clothing, including an apron, gloves and a face mask.

I will play in my room or garden with the children in my bubble for the first 45 minutes. After this time, I will be able to move between Robin Room and Wren Room and one of the gardens until circle time.

These are the teachers in Robin Room

(Team Robin - Debbie, Nicola, Emma, Angela, Sam and Donna)



These are the teachers in Wren Room

(Wren Team - Cydney, Ellie, Gemma, Lizzie, Sam and Donna)



Sometimes the teachers will need to wear a mask over their nose and mouth. This is ok, it's to keep me safe. This is what my teachers look like if they have them on.

(Team Robin - Debbie, Nicola, Emma, Angela, Sam and Donna)



(Team Wren - Cydney, Ellie, Gemma, Lizzie, Sam and Donna)



I will spend lots of my time in the gardens.



I will bring my own (named) **waterproof** jacket and trousers to wear and I will try my best to put them on myself. If I can't do it, my teachers will help me.

I will bring my own (named) wellie boots from home to change in to if I need them outside. They will be on the shelves near the door to the garden. I will try my best to put them on myself. If I can't do it, my teachers will help me.

After 45 minutes in Robin Room, I will be able to go into Wren Room and one of the gardens until circle time.



If I want a snack, I will be able to serve myself from the snack trolley in Robin Room, supported by one of the teachers. I will help clear my things away before I go back to playing.



Once I have finished playing, the teachers will help me to join my circle time group - Giraffes, Tigers or Monkeys.

Once we have had circle time, I will go back to my room for lunch or to go home if I don't stay all day.

If I need to get something from my peg, or put something in my tray, I will be able to do this on my own but my teacher will help me if I need them to.



Before lunchtime (**even if I am going home**), my teachers will take me to the bathroom to wash my hands really well. They will help me if I can't manage.

If I am staying for lunch, I will go back to Robin Room with my friends and teachers, (**only relevant if your child is staying for the whole day or coming in the afternoon**). I will sit at the table

with my friends and eat my lunch and have my drink. I will do my best to open things myself but the teachers will help me if I get stuck.

When we have finished, my teacher will help me put my lunchbox back in the lunch trolley until it's time to go home.

Once everyone has finished their lunch, I will be able to play in Robin Room and Wren Room and one of the gardens until circle time, when I will join my circle group - Giraffes, Tigers or Monkeys.

I will go back to Robin Room at home time.

My teachers will help me get my things ready to go home - I will leave my bag on my peg for next time.

I will go home from Robin garden gate



My mum/dad/carers will collect me from the gate and they will walk with me out of the school.
